Communion Reflection... Much of our lives is spent in keeping people out. We have private houses, private clubs, and so on. Of course there are times when we need to be alone. Yet there is a sense in which our size as human beings can be measured by the circles we draw to take other people in: the smaller circle, the smaller the person. A strong person isn't afraid of people who are different. A wise person welcomes them. By shutting other people out we deny ourselves the riches of other people's experience. We starve our minds, and harden our hearts. In the beginning God gave the earth its shape. He made it round. He included everybody. So should we.



It doesn't take an item of great size to help us recall memories of those we love who are no longer with us. A watch, a picture or any other small object can unleash a wealth of pleasant memories and comforting thoughts. The monetary value of the item matters little. What's really important is the person who owned it and the impact they had on our life. That impact is still felt and is in fact renewed each time we see and hold the memento. God also does great things with objects of little size or monetary value. Only a small amount of water is used at Baptism, while a mere dab of oil is all that's necessary to confer the Sacrament of the Sick or Confirmation. The consecrated host at Mass is almost weightless yet it is the true Presence of Christ Himself. If God can do all that with such small things, imagine what He could do with one of your words or acts of kindness.'

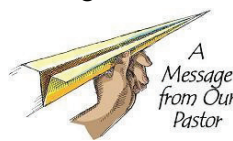


Our church is restarting its **Gardening Committee**, and we're looking for helping hands. Whether you love planting, can help with maintenance, or would like to donate
