Communion Reflection... Occasionally, we come across news about someone we haven't seen in years. To our surprise, we learn that they have become remarkably successful and are now enjoying a very prosperous life. All this surprises us because we always saw them as a rather ordinary individual with few outstanding talents. We are equally amazed when we learn of someone who we thought would go far but, in reality, has been living on the shady side of society most of their life. Jesus warned that to gain the whole world but to lose our soul in the process is no profit at all. St. Paul wrote that "the love of money is the root of all evil." Money itself is not evil. God gave gifts and talents to each one of us. Some of them are obvious while others are not. He also gave us free will to choose how we would use these gifts. We don't always make the right choices so He gives us ample time to make different ones. The time won't last forever, so use it wisely.



A man noticed a new Porsche for sale for \$50 in the classified ads. It was in mint condition with low mileage. He bought it and then asked, "Why are you selling it so cheap?"

"My husband had an affair," the woman explained. "He left a note that said, 'I'm leaving you. You can keep the house. Just sell my Porsche and send me the money.' So that's exactly what I'm doing." If you've been betrayed, you would probably like to give her a high five for getting even with her husband. Seeking revenge may feel good at first, but it's not helpful in the long run. Anger and resentment remain and motivate us to keep getting even. Our mantra becomes, "Let them see how it feels!" But this just robs us of our peace and prevents any closure. Betrayal hurts deeply. The only healthy answer is to decide to forgive. Let go of the pain and sorrow. Don't allow bitterness and retaliation to run your life and wear you down. Forgiveness doesn't say, "Let's pretend the betrayal never happened." And it's not a quick fix. It's just consciously taking our focus off the betrayal so it doesn't dominate our thoughts and harm our lives. As we gradually let it go, we'll find freedom. Until then, it holds us hostage.
