Communion Reflection... There is a way of losing by gaining. You can win an argument but lose a friend. Though competition and promotion I may advance in my profession, but in terms of relationship I am impoverished. My energies are so focused on efficiency and success that I haven't time to grow emotionally and to develop my capacity for relationships. In one's drive to attain power, a person may sacrifice friendship and loyalty, so much that one ends up alone. Lord, let me never forget your haunting words: 'What good will it do you to gain the whole world if you lose your soul?'



Jesus taught some very profound lessons using parables. These were simple stories based on everyday life and situations of His time. Not everyone was able to understand the lesson hidden in the story. Those with faith understood what He was trying to teach them. Those without faith missed the point entirely. God is still trying to teach us things using today's events. The things that happen to us as individuals as well as those events that affect our world for good or evil, all teach us something about how we make God present or absent in our life. Some acts of kindness that we witness or words of encouragement that we speak let us and others know God is still with us. All we have to do is maintain a faith filled ability to listen and learn from His modern day parables.

Have you received all of your Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Communion, Confirmations)?? Are you, or do you know someone who is, interested in becoming Catholic?? Beginning this fall, Fr. Allyn will be leading a Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) program. This will be a program that runs one day a week from November until Easter, with the candidates receiving their Sacraments at the Easter Vigil. If you are interested, or know someone who is, please see Fr. Allyn after Mass or contact the office to get a registration form.

We are also looking for volunteers to walk alongside our RCIA participants as they journey towards full initiation into the Catholic Church. Volunteers would be expected to attend the weekly meetings and participate in group discussions. No previous background in faith formation is necessary. 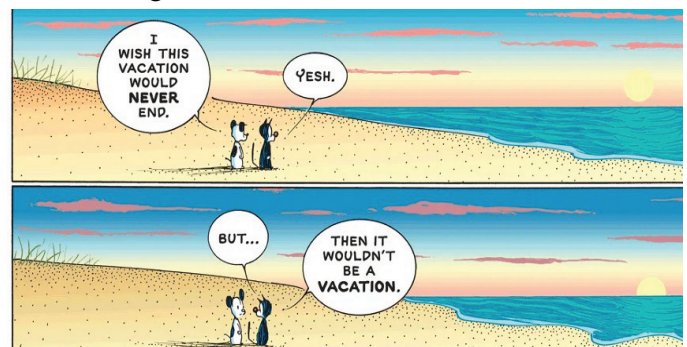
